These are the principles that we, parents, carers and school staff, shall adhere to when dropping off and collecting our children.

Speed

If driving cannot be avoided, **abide by the speed limit** of **20 MPH** – at busy times reduce your speed even further.



Environment

By **regularly walking** our children to and from school we reduce our carbon footprint and protect our environment.

If we must drive and park, we will not leave engines running. Car fumes have a serious effect on our children's health.



Etiquette

We will always act considerately and politely to the local residents.

If driving cannot be avoided, we will not block drive ways, park on corners or pavements and park considerately.



Parking

School car parks are strictly for school staff and permit holders only.

If driving cannot be avoided, we will park in the village car park or on streets away from the school and walk.



Education

As **role models** for our children we will lead by example – we will **walk**, **cycle or scoot whenever possible**.

When we must drive, we will park considerately setting a good example for our young drivers of the future.



Health and well being

Children who walk, cycle or scoot to school will have more energy and feel more ready to learn.



Drop Off

We will not drive into the school or surgery car parks.



Highway code

Always abide by the highway code including:

Not parking on yellow zig zags! Not parking close to junctions! Not driving or parking on pavements!
