English	<i>Reading</i>	The Egyptian Cinderella by Shirley Climo
	<i>Writing</i>	Use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time, place and cause, Use of present perfect form of verbs.

	<i>Written calculations</i>	Unit and non-unit fractions. Money - addition subtraction and conversion. Time – Years, months, days, hours, minutes and seconds. Roman numerals. Tell time to the minute. Shape – Measurement, comparison and recognition. Statistics – Pictograms and bar charts. Collecting and representing data.
	<i>Units of work</i>	Measurement – Length and perimeter. Measuring, comparing, adding and subtracting lengths in centimetres and millimetres. Fractions – Understanding the denominators of unit fractions, understanding the numerators of non-unit fractions, comparing and ordering non-unit fractions, placing equivalent fractions on number lines and bar models
Science	<i>Working scientifically</i>	Gathering, recording, classifying and presenting data, recording findings using simple scientific language
