Subject	Strand	Unit of work title / Overview
English	<i>Reading</i>	We will be using the book Darwin's Dragons to support our writing. We will also use a range of texts in our Guided Reading lessons to practice comprehension skills.
	<i>Writing</i>	This half term we are focusing on writing a short adventure story and a biography on Charles Darwin.
	<i>Spelling</i>	The focus will be on: dictionary work, homophones and consolidating spelling rules we have learnt this year.
	<i>Grammar</i>	Relative clauses, conjunctions, adverbials, semi colons, parenthesis.
	<i>Punctuation</i>	We will review everything we have learnt this year.
Maths	<i>Negative Numbers Converting Units Volume</i>	Understanding the difference between decimals and negative numbers. Applying our work on decimals to real life scenarios such as units and volume. We will also consolidate work on the four operations and continue to practice Arithmetic skills.
	<i>Working scientifically</i>	Identifying, classifying and grouping, comparative and fair testing, pattern seeking, researching using secondary sources, observing over time.
Science	<i>Units of work</i>	Living things and their habitats: This will involve exploring animal life cycles, plant reproduction, and classification. Students learn how mammals, birds, amphibians, and insects reproduce and develop, and compare sexual and asexual plant reproduction.
	Units of work	La Ropa – clothes – learning adjectival agreement.
Spanish	Units of work	La Ropa – clothes – learning adjectival agreement.
Geography	<i>Units of work</i>	Geographical skills and fieldwork: We will be looking at different types of settlements and how these have changed over time including the city of Leeds and the village of Bramhope.
Art	<i>Artist</i>	We will be learning about the artist Antoni Gaudi. We will learn how to use a range of techniques using clay and create our own creatures.
	<i>Units of work</i>	Sculpture: Lizards
DT	<i>Unit of Work</i>	Using levers and pulleys to make a moving object.
Music	<i>Units of work</i>	Kisne Banaaya. Songs from India and Pakistan; singing in a 4 part round and playing musical accompaniments.
RE	<i>Units of work</i>	In this unit, pupils will find out about the importance of creation within the 'Big Story' of the Bible. They will study Genesis 1 and find out about how different Christians may interpret this text in different ways comparing with science.
Computing	<i>Units of work</i>	Video production and editing – we will be looking at what makes a video, different filming techniques and how to edit.
PE	<i>Units of work</i>	Striking and fielding – the focus will be on cricket and rounders.
PSHE	<i>Units of work</i>	We will be learning about how money is used, how people can make informed and responsible spending choices, the different ways that money can be saved and kept saved and the importance of keeping track of money.
