English	<i>Reading</i>	Our focus this half term will be on learning our lines for Edith's Wartime Memory and using different Guided Reading Texts.
	<i>Writing</i>	This half term our focus will be on writing a letter to persuade.
	<i>Spelling</i>	The focus is on: 'fer' sound, 'cian' suffix, 'que' and 'gue' and WW5 Column 5
	<i>Grammar</i>	Formal language, relative clauses, fronted adverbials
	<i>Punctuation</i>	Parenthesis (brackets, dashes, commas recap), commas in list/clauses (consolidation)
Maths	<i>Units of work</i>	The focus this half term is shape, position and direction and decimals
Science	<i>Working scientifically</i>	Identifying, classifying, and grouping; Comparative and fair testing; Pattern seeking; Observing over time; Research using secondary sources
	<i>Units of work</i>	End of Living things topic and the start of Forces
Spanish	<i>Units of work</i>	Mi casa, my house
History	<i>Units of work</i>	The Kingdom of Benin – we will study how the kingdom began and ended and the main achievements.
DT/Science	<i>Units of work</i>	Floating Garden challenge: We will be investigating and designing our own floating gardens. We will look at the issues that climate change and flooding are causing around the world. This is part of our Ogden Trust enrichment.
Music	<i>Social question</i>	How does music shape our way of life?
