Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to see so many parents at yesterday's secondary school information evening. 40 parents attended and if you were unable to be there or would like to know more about secondary school options or the admissions process in general, please arrange an appointment through our admin team. I am also looking forward to speaking with parents at our next parent forum meeting on Wednesday 17 October at 9:00am. Fiona Wrightson (Chair of Governors) and I are particularly keen to meet parents who are new to the school and to hear about your child's experience of starting at Bramhope. Mr Robinson (our catering manager) will also be on hand to talk about school meals and answer any food related questions you may have. The forum will take place in the KS1 hall.

Week beginning 22 October also sees the start of parents' evenings. After school meetings will be held over two days and we would be most grateful if you could make every effort to attend. Please feel free to raise questions during your appointment but if you feel you may require more time than has been allocated, we would ask that you make an appointment on a different day. You will be able to sign up online via the ParentMail app, the sign -up sheet will go live from **4:30pm on Tuesday 16 October**.

#### **Medical conditions**

We have recently conducted a full review of our medical condition in school policy. The policy outlines the management of the administration of medication to meet the short-term medical needs and long-term care of pupils at our School.

The Policy - 'Supporting Children with Medical Conditions' can be found under the General Policies section on the website by clicking <u>here</u>. Please take a few minutes to read it as there are significant changes to our current protocol which will come into effect after half term, from Tuesday 6 November. One of the key changes is that in keeping with most schools, only medication that has been prescribed by a doctor or prescribing nurse practitioner will be administered in school. If you have any questions about our new policy, please do make an appointment with either Mrs Reynard (our First Aid lead) or myself.

Finally, a reminder that next week we are hosting our Harvest festivals. As you will remember, we are aiming to give children (and parents) a little more space this year and have therefore decided to separate the two events-Reception and KS1 at 1:30pm and KS2 at 2:30pm. Festivals will take place in KS2 hall and we look forward to seeing many of you there
