<p style="text-align: center;">Speed</p> <p>When approaching the school we will abide by the speed limit which has recently changed to 20 MPH – at busy times reduce your speed even further.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Environment</p> <p>We will not leave vehicles running around the school. Car fumes can have a serious effect on our children's health.</p> <p>By regularly walking our children to and from school we are reducing our carbon footprint and therefore protecting our environment.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Etiquette</p> <p>To uphold the image of Bramhope Primary School we will always act considerately and politely to the local residents.</p> <p>We will not block the drives of local residents and we will always park considerately</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Parking</p> <p>School car parks are strictly for school staff only.</p> <p>We will park on the streets away from the school entrances</p> <p>We will only park in the school car park if we have a 'permit' issued by the school.</p>
