## **Ongoing Road Safety Concerns**

Last Friday the Police visited us to remind parents that the car park next to the medical centre is for staff and the medical centre only, and **not for dropping** off children for school. There was an alarming incident last week witnessed by the road safety team. Please do not use this car park for dropping off children— do so only under exceptional circumstances and with prior agreement with school. We would like to thank all parents who are following the new guidelines to make our school a safer place.



Councillor Barry Anderson is trying to improve Road Safety around our schools. Here's what he's written on his website.

I've recently been raising concerns with Highways about issues in terms of parking outside of schools within the Ward and also general car parking problems in some locations. The Council have advised me that they have recently purchased a CCTV car, details of which are set out below:



"To increase safety around schools in time for the new school year, Leeds City Council is introducing new measures to tackle parking near schools and in bus stops around the city.

Drivers are being reminded that it is illegal, and can be dangerous, to park on zigzag lines near schools or pedestrian crossings and in bus stops. In order to address this the council will use a new CCTV enforcement vehicle which will record short video clips of offending vehicles.

Drivers who are caught committing an offence will receive a letter with images taken from the CCTV footage, and will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice of £70 (reduced to £35 if paid within two weeks)."



I've asked for it to be deployed around all the schools in the Ward.
