As last week, we are continuing to **revisit and revise** the letters and sounds introduced in Reception.

Our focus will be:

ff and ll

In Reception, your child has already spent a lot of time learning single letter sounds.

This week's digraphs make a familiar sound to the single letter sounds 'f' and 'l', but make a longer sound. All our words this week use these digraph/phonemes as the final sound.

Keep remembering the importance of maintaining pure sounds in order to segment and blend in reading and spelling. This is especially important in some of these words where there is a string of letters e.g. s-t-i-ff = stiff

huff

stiff

staff

fluff

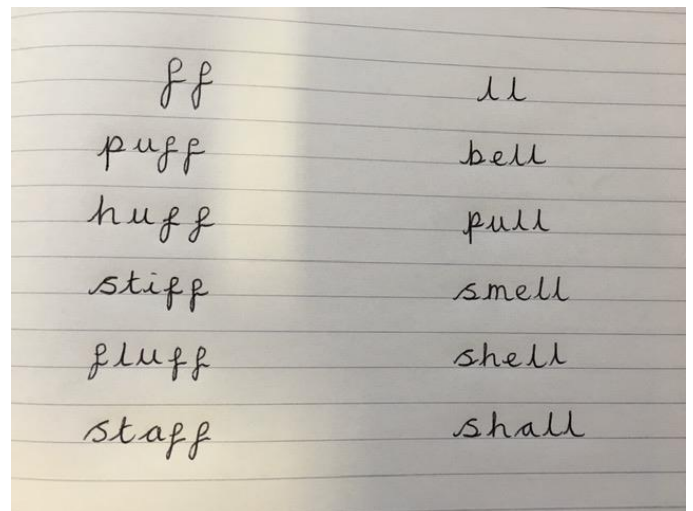
