## How did religion impact the everyday lives of people?

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The worship of the gods and goddesses was part of everyday life. People interpreted everything as an act of the gods and, because they believed in life after death, the gods would judge them so had to be obeyed.

There were lots of temples in Egypt, which really reinforces the importance of religion. Whole cities of temples arose and these complexes were of real significance.

The priests were acting on behalf of the Pharaoh, who implemented the will of the gods on Earth. He was a 'living god' and was often seen face to face with gods.

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
