Mistletoe Balls of mistletoe growing in tree tops



Drumming Listen carefully for woodpeckers hammering on tree trunks



Fungi Bracket fungi or jelly fungi on dead branches





Cushion moss in beech woods, and under oaks and conifers





Long ones, clusters, opposite pairs and big sticky ones



Nuts Can you see any squirrels or jays looking for their stores?



Drey An untidy, twiggy, squirrel nest about the size of a football



Nest Can you spot an old bird's nest in the bare tree branches?



Poo Shiny, oval-shaped droppings from roe deer
