## All About Valentine's Day

#### Who was Saint Valentine?

Valentine was a Roman priest. The Roman Emperor, Claudius, had forbidden people from getting married because he said that it was distracting the men from fighting in his army. Valentine thought that people should be able to get married if they wanted to. He secretly carried on marrying people, until he was sent to prison by the Emperor. Valentine was made a saint and people remember him every year on the 14th February, with a celebration about love.

### Cupid

Cupid is the son of the Roman goddess of love, Venus. The myths say that when Cupid shoots two people with his magic arrows, he can make them fall in love with each other.
