Grammar Activity: Sentence Types

- **Statements:** are sentences which tell you fact, opinion or idea.
- **Questions:** are sentences that ask you something. They usually end with a question mark.
- **Commands:** are often urgent or angry, can be very short and contain an imperative verb.
- **Exclamations:** are used when someone is surprised. It always starts with 'How' or 'What' and ends with an exclamation mark.
