English	<i>Reading</i>	Wolf Brother by Michelle Paver.

Maths	<i>Units of work</i>	We will read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 and determine the value of each digit. We will round any whole number to a required degree of accuracy. We will solve number and practical problems that involve balancing equations.
Science	<i>Working scientifically</i>	
	<i>Units of work</i>	Light Through a range of practical activities children will recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. They will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. They will be able to explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes. They will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.
