How does Jack's mum feel? Is the Giant happy or cross?</p>	<p>English – Phonics</p> <p>Spend 10/15 minutes learning the following sound and thinking of words with this sound in: ay</p> <p>Challenge: How many words can you think of with those sounds in?</p> <p>For example: day, pay, spray, delay and playground. Talk about what the words mean. Can you use them in a sentence?</p>	<p>English - Spelling/ writing</p> <p>Spend 5 minutes forming the following letters correctly: U,V, W</p> <p>Spend 10 minutes a day learning the following spellings: people, Mr, Mrs</p> <p>Think about and discuss a new character for your story. Where will your story be set? What will be the problem? How will you solve it? Can you write a new story?</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Watch part 5 – Fee Fi Fo Fum https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/school-radio/music-jack-and-the-beanstalk-song4/zksk47h</p> <p>Learn the song and then teach it to someone else in your household.</p> 	<p>Science – From seed to sunflower</p> <p>See the power point attached about the life cycle of a sunflower and discuss.</p> <p>Complete the seed to sunflower sheet attached.</p> <p>Challenge: Plant a sunflower seed and watch it grow.</p>

Count forwards from different starting points, for example starting at 5 and stopping at 15. Count backwards 20-0. Then count backwards from different starting points, for example starting at 13 and stopping at 7.</p> <p>Golden Beans - Activity https://nrich.maths.org/9969</p> <p>Can you write your numbers 0-20 forming them correctly?</p>	<p>PE – Playground games</p> <p>Play Simon says: Simon says bend your knees Simon says clap your hands Simon says dance Freeze Simon says jump up and down Simon says turn around Simon says shake your body Touch your toes.</p> <p>Can you think of a different move?</p>	<p>Geography/ History – Different types of houses</p> <p>See power point attached Go on a walk around Bramhope and talk about the different types of houses you see. Draw a picture of your house and label the following: roof, door, window and bricks.</p>	<p>Art/DT – Van Gogh sunflowers</p> <p>See power point attached.
